If you are a government agency, corporate entity, not-for-profit or academic organisation TADWA can collect your used and unwanted Information and Communications Technology (ICT) equipment for use in our Community Re-use and Recycling Program.

As a registered charitable organisation, we can also receive donations of unwanted equipment from State Government departments as per the State Disposal Guideline.

Certified Data Destruction

We can offer either a 3 or 7 Zero-Pass Data Wipe of your storage media. We can also provide you with a Certificate of Data Destruction showing what media was wiped, electronically degaussed or physically destroyed.

We accept almost all ICT equipment including PCs, tablets, phones, monitors, cables and other peripherals. Any equipment that has reached end-of-life and cannot be refurbished is dismantled and recycled.
